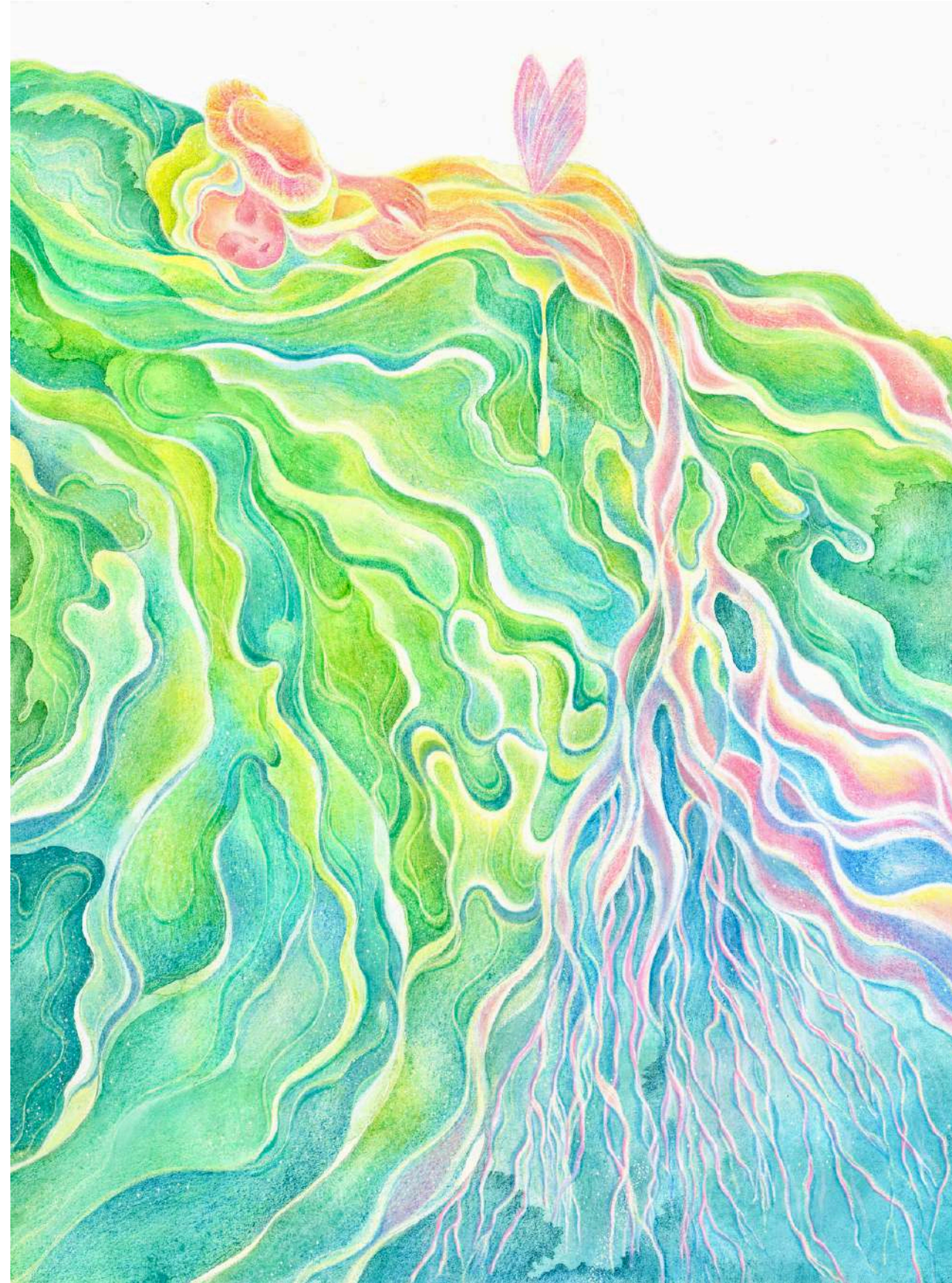

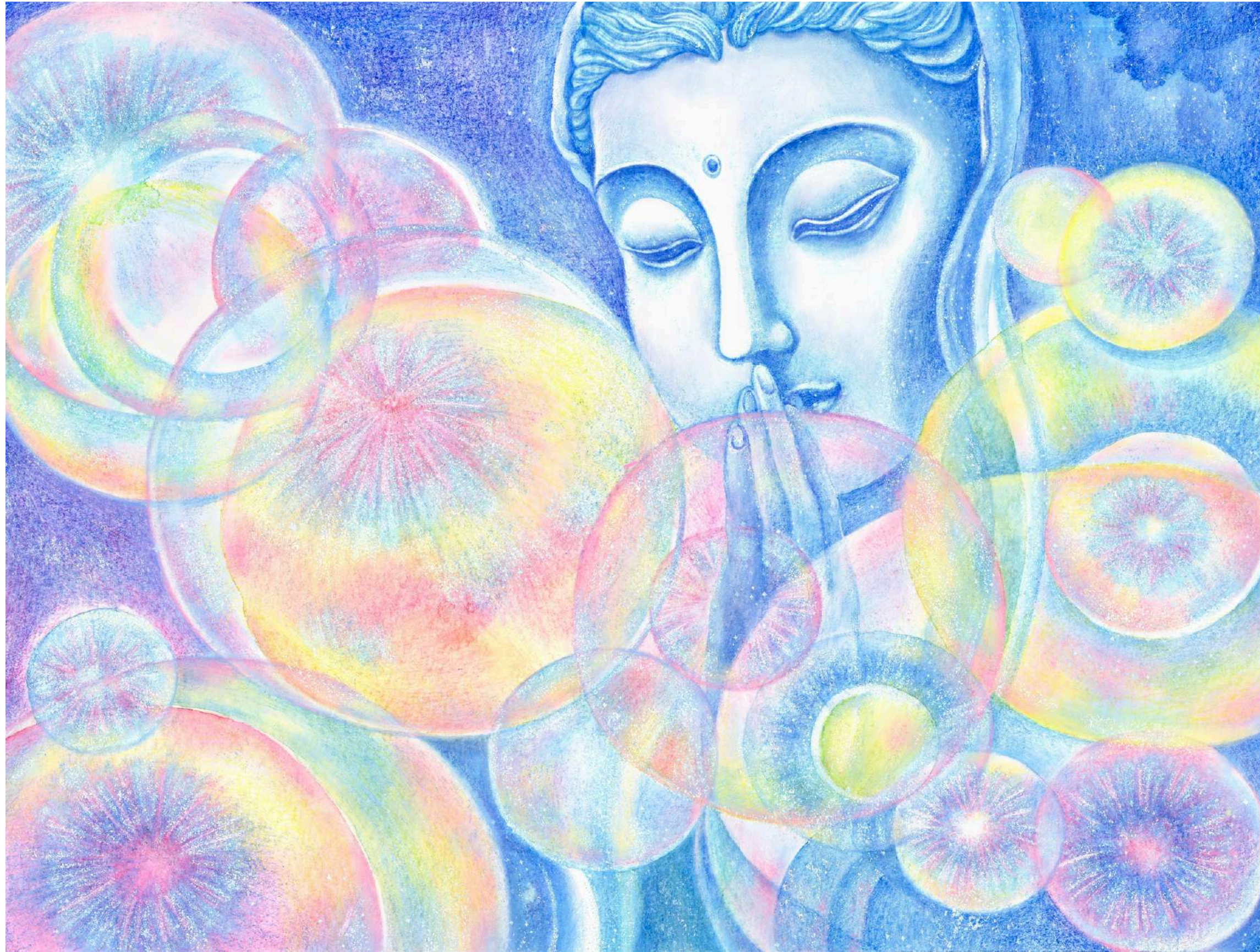
Symbiosis

Stardust

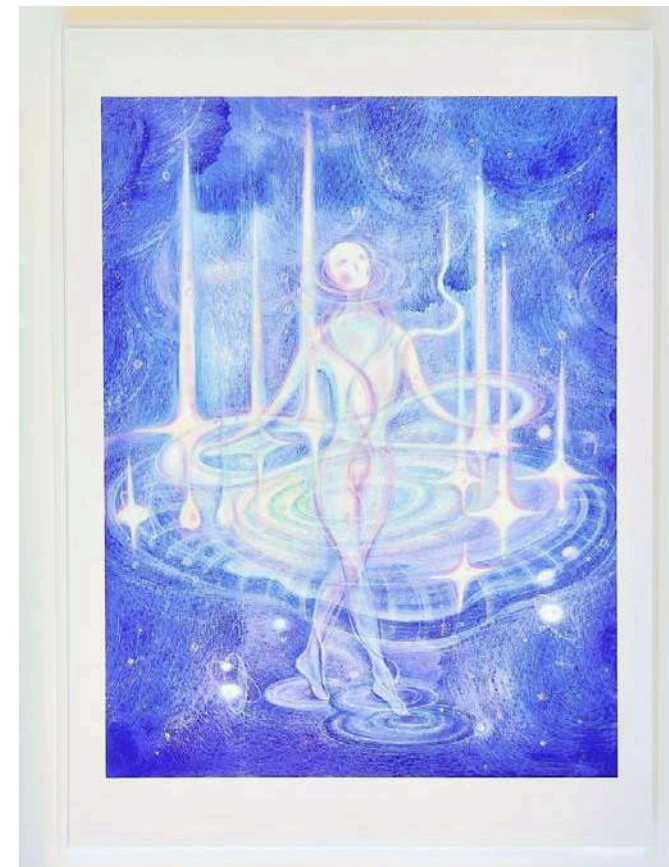
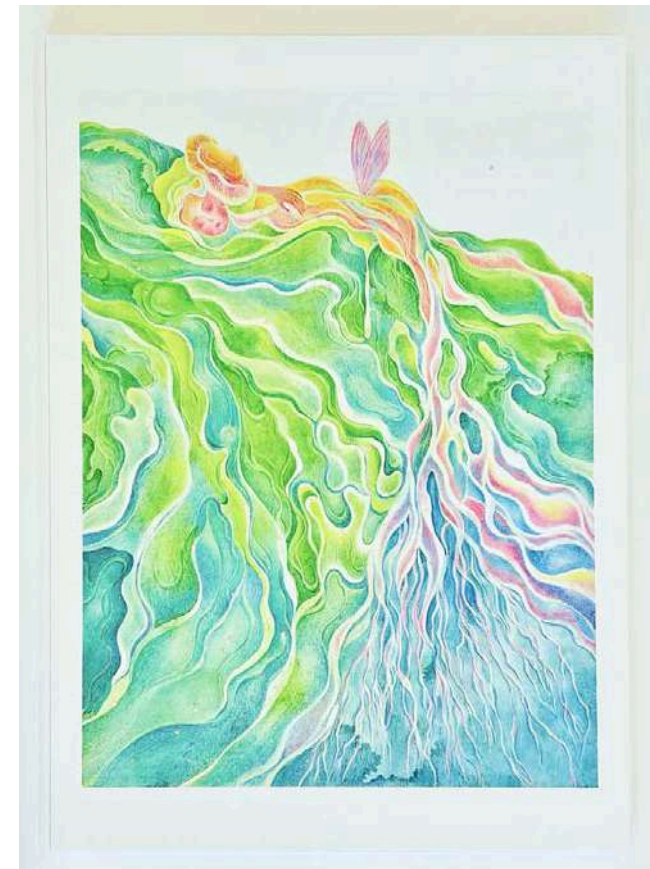
Pure Land
